Mobility grants for students and staff offered by Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin and Department of Geography and Environmental Studies, University of Nairobi, Kenya

Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin (HU) and the Department of Geography and Environmental Studies, University of Nairobi, Kenya are glad to announce a call for mobility scholarships for Master- and PhD students training for studies and teaching at HU within the academic year 2017/18 in the field of natural resources mobility and specifically on rural-urban transition and wildlife:

Programme Description - Who can apply?

Within the framework of academic collaboration between the two Partner universities students with excellent study results in the agreed field of cooperation are invited to apply for scholarships for studies, at HU Berlin.

Students will study for 3 months at HU during the summer semester 2018 from April until July 2018.

What are the prerequisites?

Students have to give proof of at least good study results in relevant fields of studies and should have a good command of English at least on the level B2.

What does the mobility scholarship to HU include?

The programme is funded with 2400-€ (allowance for living expenses) per person and the flight to Berlin and back is covered with max. 820 €. Further costs (for e.g. visa application and immatriculation fee of approx. 350-€) have to be financed by the applicant.

When will the mobility at HU take place?

13th April - 22nd July 2018

 - Copy of degree certificate qualifying for access to applied study level in original language and its English translation certified by home university,
 - Copy of academic transcript in original language and its English translation, - Language Assessment Sheet confirmed by home university or internationally recognized language test certificate (e.g. IELTS)
